



## Greater East San Carlos Community Meeting Notice Pilot Residential Parking Permit Program Mid-Year Evaluation

**Meeting Date/Time: Thursday, May 19, 2016 @ 7:00 p.m.**

You are invited to attend a community meeting to discuss the mid-year evaluation of the Greater East San Carlos (GESC) pilot residential parking permit program (Program). Public participation is an important part of evaluating the Program and City team members will be available for questions before and after the meeting. Light refreshments will be served.

### **Background:**

Developing a pilot residential parking permit program was in the conditions of approval for the Transit Village project. This condition was included to help address parking issues caused by commuters and increased development in the neighborhood.

Throughout 2015, the City and residents developed the pilot Program for the blocks south of Holly Street. Several interactive community meetings were held with City team members and the community to discuss the Program guidelines, resident questions and concerns and to gather feedback. In addition to the community meetings, residents had various opportunities to submit their feedback through the City's online forum, ***Shape San Carlos***.

The Program was adopted by the City Council in August 2015. All of the blocks in the pilot program area petitioned to be included, and the Program was implemented in the fall of 2015. Enforcement began in January 2016.

### **Mid-Year Evaluation and Next Steps:**

The Program was adopted as a pilot for one year with a six month review. During the length of the Program, residents are invited to give ongoing input through the City's app, ***Inform San Carlos***. This community meeting is an additional opportunity for residents to provide comments. The feedback that has been collected during the first six months of the Program and from the community meeting will be important to determining if any changes are necessary.

The mid-year evaluation will be presented to Council in late June 2016. In October 2016, a final review of the Program will be presented for Council to determine if the Program should be made permanent as originally instituted, modified or terminated.
